1. Certified copy of the sales tax registration should be enclosed.
2. Certified copy of latest income tax clearance certificate should be enclosed.
3. If the Tenderer is Trader, authorization from the Manufacturer of the Equipment/ Instrument quoted should be enclosed.
4. Incomplete specification offered by the Tenderer will not be considered and liable to be rejected.
5. Tender offering other optional advanced feature facilities available in the quoted equipment over and above to our requirement can be considered at our end.
6. Quotation should be submitted with satisfactory performance & Installation certificate from the reputed institute/University. The bidders must provide reference of minimum 10 installations of similar configuration.
7. The Registrar, Karnatak University, Dharwad reserves all the rights to accept or reject any lowest tenders in full or in parts or all Tender without assigning any reasons.
8. No interim queries will be entertained.
9. The equipment will have to be installed by the supplier/agent in the institute premises within 15 days from the receipt of equipment free of charges.
10. Supply will be subject to unconditional comprehensive onsite warranty for the entire equipment for the period of two years from the date of satisfactory installment.
11. The training for operating the equipment will also have to be given to the institute employee by the Tenderer without further charges.
12. The Tenderer should quote cost of the equipment and all the applicable taxes separately. Institute is applicable to central government taxes against Form D.
13. The Tenderer should quote only one rate against the tender enquiry. The Tenderer should quote for optional items separately if any.

14. If the equipment is not supplied within specified date next lowest quoted party will get order and all the losses incurred will be collected from your EMD.
15. EMD amount will be refunded after completion of tender procedures without any interest if tender rejected.
16. Bidders shall not be under a declaration of ineligibility for corrupt and fraudulent practices issued by any State Government / Government of India /Union Territory.
17. It shall be the responsibility of the Bidder to ensure credit of Tender Processing Fee and EMD into the respective receiving bank accounts of e-Procurement on or before the last date and time of bid submission.
18. The bidder is required to ensure browser compatibility of the computer well in advance to the last date and time for receipt of tenders. The departments shall not be responsible for non-accessibility of e-Procurement portal due to internet connectivity issues and technical glitches at bidder's end.
19. EMD Payments through e-Payment mode shall be made as one single transaction and payments made in part are liable for rejection.
20. Bidder shall pay Catalogue Management Module processing fees of 0.3% of the PO value (Min Rs.53/- & Max Rs.3000) soon after PO has been issued to bidder.

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
