

INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATES

1. Admission Ticket is subject to the condition that if ineligibility is detected the candidature will be cancelled.
2. Candidates are not allowed inside the examination hall without admission ticket.
3. The Candidates are required to be present at the Examination Centre half an hour before the start of the Examination of each session.
4. Scribe assistance should be arranged by the candidates who have opted for Scribe in their application. Such candidates have to produce P.H certificate.
5. Use **Black** or **Blue** ball point pen 'ONLY' for marking responses. Use of Pencil is not allowed.
6. Usage of Whitener/Eraser for changing the answers is strictly prohibited.
7. General information on the OMR sheet is pre-printed for you. Please enter the details belonging to you and sign as instructed. If you fail to do so, your paper will not be evaluated.
8. Candidates are not allowed to carry any textual material, printed or written, bits of papers, pages, mobile phone or any other electronic device except the Admission Ticket inside the examination hall.
9. There is no negative marking for wrong answer,
10. The candidates should not leave the Examination Hall without handing over their Answer Sheet.
11. On completion of the Examination, the candidate must hand over the original OMR Answer Sheet to the Invigilator in the exam hall. The candidates are allowed to take away the question Booklet along with carbon copy of the OMR sheet with them.
12. Candidates found committing malpractice, action will be taken against them as per rules.
13. Candidates are not allowed to leave the Examination Hall till the end of the session.
14. Questions are printed in multiple medium, if there is any discrepancy the question in English medium shall be considered as final.
15. Candidates shall affix their recent passport size photograph on the Admission Ticket in the space provided for the same.

Key Answers will be displayed for the Multiple choice question papers i.e. Paper-I and Paper-II respectively in Karnatak University Website (www.kud.ac.in) on the same day of completion of examination. Candidates are informed to go through the Key Answers and discrepancies, if any shall be brought to the notice of the Registrar (Evaluation) in writing within 3 days from the date of the respective examination. Grievances which are not submitted within prescribed time will not be entertained under any circumstances.
