### PREAMBLE

#### i. College Development Council:

The University has a vibrant College Development Council (CDC) established in the year 1983 with the assistance of the UGC. The CDC is headed by a Director appointed by the Syndicate. The CDC plays a key role in the establishment and development of Constituent and affiliated Colleges of the University. It functions under the joint guidance of University authorities, UGC and the State Government. It acts as a link between the UGC and State Government on the one hand and University and Colleges on the other. At present, the CDC is looking after the development of all 275 affiliated Colleges coming under the jurisdiction of Karnatak University. It also deals with running of 23 PG programmes in 60 constituent and affiliated colleges.

#### ii. To fulfill its mission and objectives, the college development council may consult other Bodies of the University concerned. The CDC takes all such steps that may fit-in for the promotion, co-ordination and enhancement of the standards of higher education. The Director is assisted by administrative and supporting staff.
